



2025 Current Stats



- TOTAL till June 5,524 Bibles & books (2,225 direct distribution i.e. personal, events, etc. and 3,269 were online orders)
- #1 province - ONTARIO - 1,023 Bibles & books were direct distribution and 1,220 online orders
- 15 Localities are on track of reaching this year's target
 - Guelph has given out 178 Bibles and books in person while there has been 1 order online. This shows the importance of direct distribution

Interesting Fact:

- In 2024, 193 Bibles and books were ordered from remote places such as NL, YT, PEI, NT, NU, and 96 Bibles and books were ordered in 2025 until now (74 from NL).

Ministry Excerpt
